- I. Welcome, Introductions and Agencies Updates
 - A. Rocio Brought FEMLA information (moms and dads)
 - B. MCAH Summary Breastfeeding 2016 Ah
 - 2016 data from MCAH program:
 - Services to pregnant & children 6 months to 1-2 years
 - O Data does not include BIH and NFP Selma
 - O Data is from programs housed at FCDPH
 - Babies First, NFP Fresno, WFRC Babies First
 - 380 clients
 - 155 women delivered
 - 126 initiated breastfeeding (81%)
 - O Lost a client at initiation and discharge = 125 client
 - Hospital discharge = 1 person still breastfeeding when discharge
 - o Half of clients breastfeeding 14 days after delivery
 - 46 of those clients exclusively breastfeeding
 - 2 months = 33 breastfeeding, 13 exclusively
 - ○6 months = 17 clients
 - ○12 months = 1 client
 - 18 months = 1 client
 - Reasons why never started or stopped breastfeeding
 - 29 moms never started
 - Bottle easier
 - Not enough milk
 - Baby preferred bottle than breastfeeding

- Discomfort
- No access to a breast pump
- 17 moms listed other reasons

- Moms who stopped breastfeeding
 - Not enough milk made
 - o Bottle was easier
 - Baby preferred bottle than breastfeeding
- Never initiated breastfeeding
 - On medications
 - On psych meds
 - Cleft lip
 - OBaby need to gain weight
 - NICU
 - o Anti-Depressants
 - Double Mastectomy
 - Wants to start smoking
 - o Difficulty bonding with
 - infant
 - Unnatural
 - Not comfortable breastfeeding

- In a rehab program
- Meds
- Stopped before 2 months, but did bf at 14 days
- CPS issue
- Mom gives baby formula
- Surgery delayed
- Miscarriage
- Olnjury to left arm
- Temporarily jaundice
- Started solids

- C. First 5 Focus Group Christy
 - Ability to drink and breastfeed
 - 3 focus groups: moms in Fresno County to see First 5 bf express, spaces, baby bags
 - o Parlier Spanish speaking
 - New Americans Hmong
 - Downtown AA
 - o Age: 18-40 yo
 - Moms who did successful breastfeeding and did not have success
 - Purpose: What First 5 can do to increase breastfeeding rates and analyze their breastfeeding efforts
 - Theresa: WIC serves = 36,000 between Fresno County and Kern County
 - Same responses from WIC clients about breastfeeding
 - Barrier = coming to the door to get the services
 - Gaps: Agencies say they have these resources; Moms say there is none
 - Ah: Do they know about breastfeeding? Do they want to breastfeed? Or have the intention to breastfeed?
 - Susan: 14 days breastfeeding (only half)
 - Ah: Responses are still the same about breastfeeding
